BP 2.1 ROLE OF THE BOARD

Outcome:

The board shall govern and monitor the operations of the school division.

Interpretation of Policy:

- Students receive learning opportunities that are consistent with provincial requirements and are delivered within the framework of the board’s vision, mission and beliefs.
- The board will govern rather than manage and make decisions as a corporate body.
- Linkages between communities, delegations to the board and partnership groups to better reflect educational values.

Compliance Demonstrated:

- Set a balanced budget.
- Act as a final authority for appeals.
- Director reports on partnership agreements.
- Newly developed school viability policy and process.
- Linkages with the partners and electors.

Compliance in Process:

- The importance of governing rather than managing needs to be understood by all board members.
- When conducting board business all board members need to understand the educational process.
- School viability policy has been revised and updated after consultation with electors.

Recommendations: no revisions to policy recommended.
