A familiar figure will soon become a Superintendent of Education with the Sun West School Division. Shelley Hengen, the Supervisor of Student Services and Special Education Consultant with the Sun West School Division, has been appointed to succeed Lynne Dressler, who superannuates at the end of the 2010 school year. Hengen's appointment will come into effect on August 1, 2010. Hengen will be responsible for Student Services, which will include Special Education, and will have supervisory responsibilities for schools on the west side of the school division.

Prior to starting work with Sun West as a Special Education Consultant in 2006, she had held the same position with the former Outlook School Division since 2003. Hengen has also worked as a Student Services Counsellor and Educational Psychologists for the former Saskatoon (East) School Division.
