

Eaton School

Eaton School is located in Eatonia, a town of 449 people located 44 kilometres south west of Kindersley on highway 44. Agriculture is the primary industry in Eatonia with the town also serving as a social service, education, business, cultural and recreation centre for its area. Eaton School offers Kindergarten to Grade 12 classes and has a current enrollment of 126 students. Projections indicate a decline in enrollment. The Eaton School attendance area includes the communities of Laporte and Mantario. The schools closest to Eaton School that offer the same grades are Kindersley Composite School (8-12), Elizabeth School (K-7) and Westberry School (K-7), all in Kindersley. The elementary wing of the school was built in 1956 with a separate two-storey high school building constructed in 1962. The two wings were joined by a gymnasium in 1965 but the high school wing was destroyed by fire and re-built in 1967. The school was partially renovated in 1985 when a band room was added. In order to install adequate drainage, in 1999, a major project was undertaken to excavate the perimeter of the school and add front landscaping. The school's PAA lab is in a separate unattached building that was formally a school bus garage.
