

Lucky Lake School

Lucky Lake School is located in Lucky Lake, a village of 225 people, 119 kilometres south-east of Rosetown. Agriculture is the basis of the local economy and Lucky Lake is an education, recreation, health and service centre for the surrounding area. During the summer months, Lucky Lake also provides services for tourists visiting Danielson Provincial Park and nearby resort villages. Lucky Lake School is a Kindergarten to Grade 12 school with a declining enrollment, currently of 123 students. Beechy School is the nearest school. The Lucky Lake School attendance area includes the villages of Dunblanc, Birsay and the resort villages of Hitchcock Bay and Coteau Beach. Lucky Lake School was built in 1964 and originally included five classrooms, offices, washrooms, change rooms and a gymnasium. In 1972, four more classrooms and additional washrooms were added and in 1979, two more classrooms were added. The former Birsay School was moved to Lucky Lake and added to the school in 1985, which provided the school with four more classrooms, additional washrooms and a PAA lab.
