Background


Alternative courses provide schools with the ability to broaden program opportunities.

Procedures

1. Director/Superintendent of Education with responsibility for Student Support Services consultation and approval is required prior to submission of an alternative course application. Colony school applications are to be sent to the Superintendent of Education/designate with responsibility for the colonies.
2. Application to the Director is to be made on the forms provided by the Ministry of Education.
3. Board approval is required before an application is submitted to the Ministry of Education for an alternative course.
4. A Student Support Services Consultant and/or Learning Consultant will provide assistance with course development.
