### Background

The Division provides driver education in accordance with the Education Act, provincial curriculum, and the Division agreement with SGI.

### Procedures

1. Principals are responsible for scheduling driver education in cooperation with the Driver Education Instructor.
2. The Principal is to discuss the requirements for driver education with the driver education instructor early in the school year. This may include, but not limited to arranging classroom and in-car instruction scheduling, trips to larger centres (if applicable) and general communication.
3. The Principal is to ensure that final marks are submitted to SGI and recorded on the Ministry of Education Student Data System.
4. The Principal is to report to the Director or designate any on-going or major concerns with the program.
