**Background**

The Division supports the concept that the educational program in schools is to encourage healthy physical development of students and to develop a life-long emphasis on wellness.

**Procedures**

1. The instructional program in each school is to include the provincially recommended time for physical education.
2. Students are to comply with the physical education dress standards prescribed by their school.
3. A service or volunteer program in physical education and intramural and co-curricular programs may be provided when deemed appropriate.
4. School staff will refer to the Sport/Physical Activity Handbook regarding safety procedures.
5. Each Principal will ensure that the Sport/Physical Activity Handbook is reviewed annually by school staff at the beginning of the school year.
6. Activities within the Sport/Physical Activity Handbook have been approved for use in Division schools providing teachers/schools follow the recommended guidelines for equipment, facilities, instruction and supervision.
