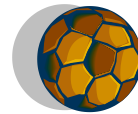


Grade 6 Art

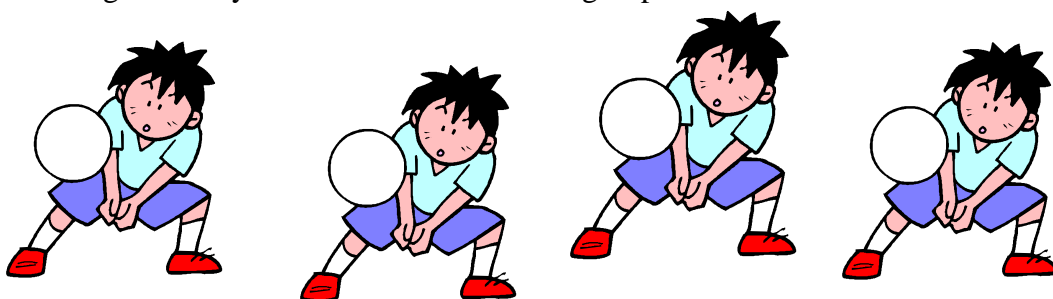
