Background

The Division requires all employees to concern themselves with the physical, social and emotional welfare of each student. Abuse or neglect of children and youth must not be left unchecked by persons charged with the care of students.

Procedures

1. Reporting Children in Need of Protective Services
 - 1.1 The Director or designate is responsible for ensuring school-based personnel have access to the most current information about children needing protective services.
 - 1.2 Principals are to familiarize themselves and their staffs with procedures and information regarding the reporting of children in need of protective services as addressed in the Saskatchewan Child Abuse Protocol 2014. Refer to form 330-1 Confirmation of Investigation by Ministry of Social Services or Police Services.
 - 1.3 Principals and teachers shall cooperate with Social Services in accordance with the protocol.
